Things from home...

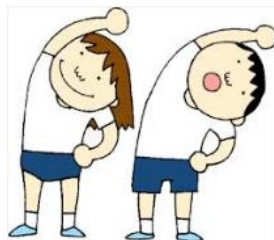
Thank you for your support in not bringing things from home we have noticed a big improvement.
