If you have any questions about your child's learning or how best you can help them at home, please do not hesitate to ask myself or Miss Allen.

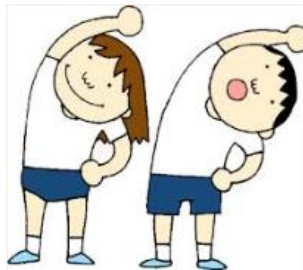


### Attendance
