As you are already aware, Year Three now share the Key Stage One playground so we ask that Year Two parents now drop off and collect children from the playground and not outside the classroom. Teachers will bring the class to the playground at the end of the day.

The Big Adventure

This term in NICER, each class will be researching a famous scientist and will create a fact file and portrait on this person.

Alongside this children will use a TASC wheel to design an interesting snack for parents using their scientific knowledge. All of this work will be shown at our science fair at the end of this half term.

Our class text is Katie Morag. Children will be exploring their local area and compare this to the Isle of Struay. They will create a simple map and use basic map skills to follow routes.
