It will take place on the afternoon of Friday 13th July—more details will follow.


We have recently sent out details of Times Tables Rock Stars.

<u>Our Learning</u>

NICER - Our theme is Dinosaur Stomp where will be learning about life millions of years ago. In science, we shall be continuing to learn all about plants.

English - We will be covering a range of text types including recounts , poetry and factual reports. While doing this we will be improving our spelling strategies, sentence writing and handwriting.

Maths - This half term we will be learning about fractions, time, and the properties of shapes as well as regular arithmetic activities. Continued support with your child learning their 2, 5, 10, 3 and 4 times tables (and beyond!) would be much appreciated.

P.E.—We will continue with swimming this half term and will focus on athletics and dance in our other sessions. P.E. & Swimming
