We hope you have all had a lovely Easter break.

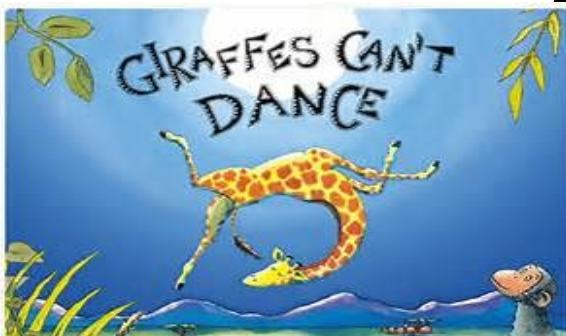

This half term we start our new Learning Challenge—**How can we help People Who Help Us the Most?**

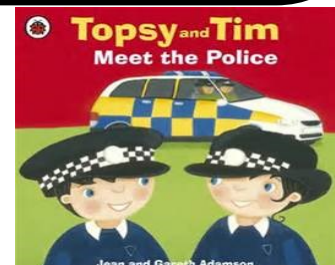
We will be spending this half term looking at people who help us. We have set up a doctor's surgery and a police station in Nursery and the children have been very active looking after lots of poorly children!
