On the same day (Friday 18th January), NSPCC staff, working in partnership with telephone communications company O², will hold a parent workshop session at Rowley Park Academy. This session will provide practical advice for parent in supporting their children will all aspects of internet safety. It will cover: how to ensure children understand how to be safe online, offer support with setting appropriate parent controls for your child, advice and information on online games, their risks and age recommendations. It will also provide parents with the opportunity to ask questions and find further support about online safety.

Other schools who have arranged these sessions, have had an extremely positive response from parents who attended and we feel that this is such an ever changing, it's vitally important that parents know the facts, risks and gain practical advice to keep their children safe online.

The workshop will be run by NSPCC staff and O² gurus and will take place on **Friday 18th January**.
