On the Friday before half term, we took part in Show Racism the Red Card day ran by the Football Association. The children were very mature and had in depth conversations about the topic and events.

We started the day in KS2 with an assembly exploring what racism is and the impact it can have on society and in KS1 we shared a story to explore and discuss how people should be treated equally. The children then spent the day in classes learning about racism, its impact and how we as a school should make a stand. The children then worked together to make a pledge board of actions and reasons to say no to racism and celebrate each other's difference.

The children really had a good day and learnt a lot from each other.
