In Maths we will be continuing our learning of numbers 1-5. We will have a number focus each week, which will also be reinforced through our play.

We will also continue developing our early phonics skills. So far, we have practiced listening to sounds, exploring instrumental sounds and body percussion. We will further develop these skills by exploring alliteration and voice sounds this half term.
