Our Learning Journey

Our theme this half term is 'Community Heroes'. Each week, we will focus on a different occupation where a person helps us. We will also be having visitors into school to talk about their jobs, for example a Doctor, Post Man and Vet.

We will be doing lots of work about shapes during our Maths learning, identifying shapes and creating shapes. As well as this, we will also continue our learning of numbers to 5, our skills to subitise these numbers, write them and match objects to them.

In Literacy we are focusing on writing our names, and then forming some letters in our name independently. During phonics, we are learning about rhyming words, identifying these in stories and songs, and making up our own.

Homework Focus
