Following the Bake Off, our Autumn term challenge pack is called; '80 beats around the world. This challenge pack will lead us around the world learning about different countries culture and geographical features. For our Hook, Year 3 and 4 will have a visit from a music company to inspire the children with a demonstration of music from a selected country. The outcome of our challenge will be to see if we can represent Music from around the world. We look forward to sharing our Outcome with you before Christmas.

# English

After recipe writing linked to our Bake Off, this term we will be writing a travel journal in the style of our class text 'The Boy Who Biked the World', followed by a letter to a child in Brazil. After half term we will be writing character descriptions and retelling our second-class text; 'The Jungle Book'.

## Maths

This term in Maths this term we will be covering place value to identify numbers to 1,000 and find 1,10 or 100 more and less. Also, we will be exploring a range of methods to add and subtract up to two 3-digit numbers including when we need to exchange. Before Christmas, we will begin to cover multiplication and division, finding equal groups and exploring methods to multiply.

### P.E

Our PE sessions will be on Monday (Swimming) and Wednesdays.

Your child will need to bring in their swimming kit and a towel in order to take part. If for any particular reason your child is unable to take part please speak to myself or Mrs. Proudman.
