Our new challenge pack is called 'Really Rural, Utterly Urban' and focusses on Geographical features of the world around us. We will be learning the difference between rural areas and urban areas, visiting Lower Drayton Farm for a trip to the countryside and we will also be going on a local walk! Our challenge outcome will focus on making a locally sourced traditional breakfast.

Spring Term –Year

English

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We have started the term with some non-fiction, writing our letters to a local farmer, looking at which features to include. We will be reading and writing using stories such as 'Farmer Duck' and the 'Enormous Turnip' as inspiration before having a look at some poetry. Our sentences are looking fab as we have been working on our handwriting!

Maths

We started off the term with a look at 3D and 2D shapes, consolidating our understanding of all the different features. We continue to use concrete, pictorial and abstract concepts to develop our counting beyond 10. We will be strengthening our understanding of place value in the coming weeks and improving our recall – particularly on our number bonds.
