Our Deep-Water challenge pack will begin with the children investigating what types of waterways can be found in our local area and how they are used. During our visit to Wolseley Bridge, the children will complete fieldwork to investigate the features of our local waterways. Following our trip, we will research into how the industrial revolution changed the UK and Stafford's waterways. We will also be focusing on how we can use data basses to collect, present and compare data linked to our local waterways. Finally, for our challenge outcome, we will create a digital presentation to share with the local council on how we can have a positive impact on our local waterways,

# English

This term, we will be writing a balanced argument linked to our class text; Deep Water. Following this, we will be recreating a story similar to 'A Town is by the Sea' with a focus on Stafford. In the second half term, we will be writing a diary entry as if we were a child in the mines during the industrial revolution. Finally, linked to our challenge outcome, we will be writing a persuasive speech to the local council.

## Maths

This term in Maths we will be continuing our learning of multiplication and division to multiply and share 2-digit numbers. Also, we will then be learning about different units related to length and perimeter. The children will be completing many practical activities measuring, comparing and finding equivalent measurements.


