NICER

Our NICER challenge pack this term is 'It's All Greek To Me!'. Within this, Year 4 will be looking to plan and deliver a sports day as their challenge outcome. They will be looking at the history of the Ancient Greeks and how they have impacted modern day life. We will be linking our NICER work to other subjects across the curriculum so that we can widen our understanding. Within English, we will be working alongside our NICER curriculum. We will be focusing on a playscript, a recount and non-chronological report linking our pieces of writing to our focus books and to the relevant topic we are covering in NICER.

Maths

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Throughout the term, children will be exploring a variety of topics within Maths. These include: Decimals, Money, Time, Shape, Statistics, Length and Perimeter and Position and Direction.

Alongside this, children are encouraged to practice their timestables, which can be accessed on TT Rockstars or a copy of the timestables can be send home on request.
