Science

As part of our science lessons this half term, children will be exploring the impact of diet, exercise, drugs (legal and illegal, smoking, vapes and alcohol) and lifestyle on the way their bodies function. Maths

We will begin the term by finishing our topic of Decimals and Percentages. As the term unfolds, we will be exploring: Perimeter and Area, Statistics, Shape, Negative Numbers and Converting Units.

P.E

Our PE days remain on Tuesday's and Wednesday's. The topics covered in PE this term are athletics and striking games.

Children will also partake in Time 4 Sport sessions for the first half term, with a focus of health and wellbeing.

This half term, Year 5 will explore the diverse places of worship, understanding the significance of sacred places in various religions.
