# Curriculum Challenge

Year 1 are diving into an unforgettable adventure with our topic: Buckets, Spades and Umbrellas! From a real trip to the beach to uncovering what seaside life was like in Victorian times, we will be exploring the world's continents and oceans, and discovering the impact of pollution on our precious marine animals. To bring all our learning to life, the children will be creating and performing their very own seaside-themed puppet show!

Our English learning will be closely linked to our Challenge Curriculum, providing meaningful and exciting writing opportunities. Children will explore a range of texts including The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch, Flotsam and Somebody Swallowed Stanley to inspire creative narrative writing.

We will also write a postcard from a holiday destination, create an animal fact file, and deliver a persuasive speech about the impact we have on our oceans.

## Maths

This term, children will continue to develop their number confidence by exploring multiplication in 2s, 5s and 10s, and learning how to divide by sharing into equal groups. They'll also be introduced to fractions, focusing on recognising and finding halves and quarters. In addition, we will be deepening our understanding of place value up to 100, and beginning practical work with money and time, including telling the time to the hour and half hour
