Our challenge pack this term is "Buckets, Spades and Umbrellas" which will take children on a journey through time as they explore the fascinating world of beaches and coastlines. From the golden sands of today's holiday hotspots to the elegant seaside resorts of the Victorian era, children will delve into the geography, history and environmental issues that shape our coasts.

English

This term, our English lessons will be closely linked to our topic 'Buckets, Spades and Umbrellas'. Children will explore a variety of rich and engaging texts inspired by beaches, coastlines and environmental themes. They will read and write across a range of genres, including persuasive texts about protecting our coastlines, narratives set in seaside locations, and postcards that capture the magic of a day at the beach.

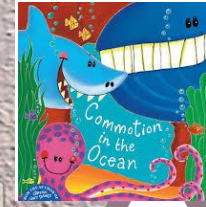
