Challenge curriculum

This term, the children's challenge pack is "Let us entertain you".

We will explore key periods through time and find out how theatre has change over time.

We will be learning all about what it takes to put on a performance, looking at scripts, seeing backstage at a theatre and experiencing a theatre production for ourselves.

This will all lead to us creating our own final performance for our friends and families.

English

In English, children will be learning about a variety of different fiction and non-fiction. We will be writing stories with a flashback, our own biographies and exploring playscripts. We will continue to extend our own vocabulary to improve our writing and experiment with sentence structure and it's effect on the reader.

Maths

In mathematics, we will be focusing statistics, 2D and 3D shape and translating and reflecting shapes in all 4 quadrants.

In the build-up to the SATS we will have a large focus on mathematics in preparation for the Year 6 Arithmetic paper. Wherever possible, please encourage pupils to review this work at home. Revision guides have been made available.
